A “*Short Term Course on Academic Leadership*” was organized in this minority institution from 19.10.2016 to 25.10.2016 under the scheme run by UGC-HRDC, AMU for minority managed Degree colleges. Total 45 lecturers from 4 minority managed institutions participated in it.

It was held in three sessions daily in the conference hall of Nayab Abbasi Girls P.G. College, Amroha (U.P.) with the address by resource persons arranged by AMU HRDC. Only two resource persons were allowed to be managed by this host college which was done properly.

Prof, Parvez Talib was the main source of inspiration and guidance to the teaching community of this area. He devoted three days for this programme and was kind enough to stay permanently in the pollution free atmosphere, like Shantiniketan, of this institution. Generally, the faculty members of all the four colleges took keen interest in the programme, learned a lot and improved their teaching and leading skill.
